- Sened Organization was established in response to the urgent needs of millions of afflicted Syrians in Syria and Türkiye.
- Later, our projects in Türkiye expanded to include support for the host community and Syrians alike.
- Our work extends across various sectors of humanitarian work, with a particular focus on advocating for the rights and well-being of people with disabilities, their families and the community.

Earthquake response:




Since the February 6, 2023 earthquake that struck central Türkiye and northwestern Syria, our organization immediately provided effective support to affected Syrians and Turks in both countries. During the first days of the earthquake, Sened established emergency response centers in Syria and Turkey. Our initiatives and response included: life-saving assistance, protection activities, health care services, shelter and food provision, and cash assistance projects.
